3. Read together and discuss Romans 8:28-39. What are some of the things it says about how God continues to care for humans? What can separate us from God's love?
4. What do you think angels look like? Why? Read Luke 1:26-38; Luke 24:4-7; Psalm 103:20-21; Psalm 91:11-12. What do we learn about angels from these passages?

Close in prayer thanking God for caring for you individually and for angels.

Y Read together pages 110-112 & 116-119 specifically questions 99-100, 108-113 from Luther's Small Catechism.

1. What does the word angel mean? Briefly describe the four things that the Bible says about angels.
2. Read together Luke 12:22-34. What does Jesus use as examples from creation to show how God still takes care of creation? How can this passage be a comfort to us? How does this passage teach us how to think about "our things"?
3. How can we be good stewards of creation?
4. Read together Psalm 145. What are some of the ways that this Psalm says that God takes care of humans? What are some specific things that God has done to take care of your family? What are some issues or events going on in your life now or in the near future that you as a family need God to take care of for you?
