3. As true God Jesus was with the Father since the beginning of time, long before He became a man. What does this say about Jesus’ power in relation to God the Father? How does this personally help you to better understand Jesus?
4. Read together and discuss Luke 1:26-38. How does this passage show Jesus as true God and true man? (Hint: it’s in the Creed) How do you think Mary felt when she realized that she was to give birth to God’s Son?

Major Point:

The second part of the Apostle’s Creed talks about the two natures of Jesus. The belief that Jesus is both true God and true man is a very unique and important part of our Christian faith.
